STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

1. Advice on Airport Pick-Up Service

- ❖ We offer advice to support incoming international students by providing a list of transportation providers offering airport pick-up services for those arriving in Singapore.

2. New Student Orientation Programme

3. Information on Accommodation

- An International Student in Singapore spends on average about S\$800 to S\$2500 a month on living expenses. This amount can vary depending on individual lifestyles.
- These estimated cost ranges below give a rough guide of the basic expenditure an International Student may face in Singapore per month.

Item	Cost Per Month (SGD)
Accommodation	\$800-\$2500 (Rental varies according to geographical area, type of accommodation, demand, facilities provided and number of people sharing)
Utilities	\$50-\$200 (Not applicable for hostel)
Food	\$300-\$600 (Based on \$10-\$15 a day for 3 meals)
Public Transport	\$100-\$200 (Varies on type of student concession pass)
Telecommunications	From \$50 onwards (Varies with the usage and packages subscribed)

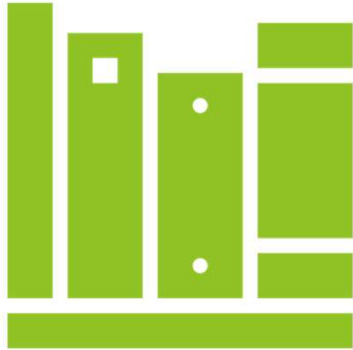

4. Information on Medical Insurance and Allied Health Services

However, the school can assist by providing a list of medical insurance agents for students to engage with. This includes leading insurance companies in Singapore such as AIA Singapore, Income Insurance Singapore, Aviva, Great Eastern Life, and AXA.
